

Let's imagine what this could look like with the help of Microsoft's Modern Workplace solutions.

Real estate professionals can host virtual open houses through the live event feature of Microsoft Teams. The event can be open to the public or invite-only. By enabling the Q&A feature, prospective buyers can interact with the agent or broker and send in their questions about the property.

To follow up with an interested buyer, an agent or broker can schedule a meeting through Microsoft Teams. In preparation for the meeting, they open up OneNote to see all their past meeting notes in one place, including relevant files and links to properties the client has shown interest in.

The client simply clicks on the meeting link to instantly connect to the real estate professional. The two can chat via audio or video, and the agent or broker can share their screen to show further details about the property, such as photos or a floor plan.

Whether meeting with clients or collaborating with team members, digital platforms are making it easier than ever to connect with each other.

UTILIZE DIFFERENT COMMUNICATION METHODS

As more interactions move online, strong communication with clients and between team members is more important than ever. By using different methods of communication—from emails and instant messages to audio and video calls—

team members can stay connected throughout their day.

With <u>Microsoft 365 Business</u>, real estate professionals get access to a range of communication tools, all in one convenient plan. This includes business-class email through <u>Microsoft Exchange</u> and audio and video conferencing through

<u>Microsoft Teams</u>. Real estate professionals can even grant <u>guest access</u> to a client. This means that the agent and client can have a shared portal to store documents, such as property listings, and to chat or set up meetings



HOST VIRTUAL TOURS

Virtual property showings ensure the safety of agents, brokers, buyers, and sellers. Understandably, prospective buyers will want to see a property in-person before committing to such a significant purchase. However, virtual tours, live streams, and video calls can help clients narrow down their selection and reduce the number of in-person showings.

With Microsoft Teams' <u>live event</u> and video conferencing features, real estate professionals can offer their clients a variety of safe viewing options. The agent or broker simply sends a meeting or event link, and the client, whether they have a Teams account or not, can easily join from their device.

As more employees continue to work away from the office, it's important to find new ways to keep them engaged with the company. Seeing colleagues everyday may not be a viable option anymore, but engagement in the modern workplace can take on new forms.



SHARE AND UPDATE INFORMATION

To keep employees engaged, they need up-to-date information on what is happening within the company. Rather than sending emails that can easily be missed, consider having a portal to share files, news, and announcements.

To keep team members on the same page, real estate professionals can use Microsoft Teams to share industry news and workplace announcements. Team members can also upload and share common documents or resources, such as purchase or listing agreements, which will then be stored on the team's SharePoint site. To ensure communications are seen, team members can mark their message as urgent or use @mentions to send a notification directly to a colleague. With the Microsoft Teams mobile app, team members can stay informed, even when they are on the go.

CREATE SPACES FOR CASUAL CONVERSATIONS

The varying schedules of real estate professionals combined with team members working across locations can make it difficult to connect. To boost engagement, find avenues where colleagues can have different types of interactions outside of emails and meetings.

On Microsoft Teams, <u>channels</u> are sections that are dedicated to specific topics or projects. Channels can be used to set up communities of practices or to discuss current trends. Consider also having a "water cooler" channel, where team members can chat about unrelated topics. This can help create more human connections between colleagues.

KEEP IT IN THE CLOUD

In the modern workplace, it's important that files and documents can be accessed anywhere, especially if employees are working remotely or travelling between different properties. By keeping data on secure cloud storage, agents and brokers can access work when and where they need.

Team members can access recordings when they need to catch up on a meeting. Recordings can also be automatically transcribed. If a team member is looking to review a specific portion of the meeting, they can easily search the transcript to locate important discussion items.
